This web application is use to send loads/credits on mobile in Philippines anywhere in the world. The said application is only available to those who have relatives using Globe or Touch Mobile provider in Philippines. Users may register and must have PayPal account to be able to use this service.

This web application is a local version of PaysetterXpress International but this time it doesn't use Paypal, this application uses ATM accounts under Bancnet and/or Megalink and only available within the Philippines. Also, this application is capable of sending Gcash (domestic remittance only) for those who wishes to send money to their love ones within the Philippines.

Both applications are using the same URL, but there is a redirector that can detect if the users are accessing within the Philippines or accessing out side the Philippines, if it's within the vicinity of the Philippines, it will redirect to Local version which uses ATM's of Bancnet and Megalink account, if it's from the other country, it will redirect to International version which uses Paypal account.

Both applications are developed using Jsp/Servlets and Struts with Oracle as database, used Tomcat as application server under Linux environment.
